Fabio Scalia Salon + Art Space is pleased to present the ***Super Stellar series*** by esteemed multi-media artist, Denise Amses'. *Super Stellar* is a collection of works on paper drawn from Amses' keen interest in geometric shapes, cosmic imagery and related industrial forms translated into synthesized constellations, bodies of light and brilliant colors. The exhibition is made up of limited edition woodblock prints and mono prints.



Known for her large-scale etched-glass installations, such as **Circle In**, which was the final feature in the recent multi-year 20 million dollar renovation of the Empire State Building lobby project. According to the artist; “**Circle In** floats between two and three dimensions, richly layering thousands of star and circle patterns onto line patterns.” Her brightly colored prints continue this inquiry but on a more intimate scale.

The artist creates her work through a multi-step process of drawing cutting and carving. Similar to iconic artists such as Pablo Picasso, Amses often works in simultaneity, alternating between her signature mediums of glass and wood block printing, allowing for one discipline to feed into the other.

For the last three decades the artist erected many prestigious large-scale public glass and light installations throughout the United States. She has a permanent installation at 30 Rockefeller Center (a 12 ton multi-layered sculpture made of light, crystal, steel, etched glass and stone) along with many other works located in various public spaces such as; hotels, hospitals, corporate spaces and universities. Her work is also among many private collections.
